BACKGROUND

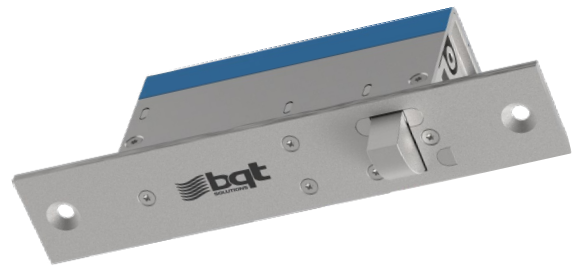
A renowned museum was undergoing a broader upgrade of its security infrastructure, including access control on its oversized, framed glass doors. Given the building's architectural significance and high public visibility, any updates needed to respect its carefully maintained visual identity.

CHALLENGE

The key challenge was implementing stringent access control on large, heavy, framed glass doors without disrupting the museum's welcoming, visitor-friendly environment. Adding to the complexity was the need for a customised faceplate, which had proven difficult to source while meeting both functional and aesthetic requirements.

SOLUTION

The YD30S, with a custom bronze faceplate was created for the museum. This tailored solution preserved the visitor-friendly atmosphere while ensuring high security, with integrated access control that seamlessly worked with their existing security infrastructure.
